The conference is a scientific event in which teachers, staff, graduate students, masters and university students (in collaboration with a supervisor), independent researchers, managers and specialists of enterprises and organizations are invited to participate.

Purpose of the conference:

- promote the development and popularization of scientific knowledge in the study of historical experience and new technologies in the field of architecture, design and construction;
- attracting gifted students and young scientists to solve current scientific, technical and technological problems;
- development of scientific potential and activation of research and innovation activities of students, undergraduates, and graduate students;
- expanding scientific and practical connections and strengthening cooperation in order to exchange information, experience and achievements, including with the councils of young scientists from other higher educational institutions;
- approbation of the results of scientific research of students, undergraduates and graduate students;
- strengthening international scientific interaction between students and young scientists from different countries.

Thematic areas of the conference:

- 1. Architectural innovations, new materials and technologies.
- 2. Prospects for the development of architectural and construction education.
- 3. Preservation of identity and historical and cultural heritage.
- 4. Issues of sustainable urban development:
- formation of a comfortable urban environment by means of landscape architecture;
- issues of strategic urban and landscape planning and urban resilience;
- environmental issues of the urban environment and energy supply.

Key dates:

Until May 5, 2024, registration of participants for the conference and submission of materials for publication

June 4 – 5, 2024 conference days.

Forms of participation in the conference (hybrid):

- presentation of a plenary report up to 20 minutes;
- presentation with a sectional report up to 10 minutes;
- participation in a conference without a report (publication of materials in a collection).

Presentation format: face-to-face, online.

Working languages: Turkmen, Russian, English.

Participation in the conference is free.

Within the framework of the conference it is planned:

- publication of a collection of materials;
- the conference program includes a competition of reports. A competition for the best report is held as part of the conference. Conference participants evaluate the participant's oral presentation according to the following criteria:
 - relevance and novelty of the conducted scientific research;
 - quality of presentation accompanying the report;
 - competence of the speaker (knowledge of the topic);
 - speech culture of performance.

The authors of the best reports are awarded diplomas. The diploma is sent electronically to the email address specified in the application.

Procedure for submitting materials:

Note: The materials of the reports are considered accepted after receiving the corresponding notification from the Organizing Committee of the conference. The collection of materials will be published by the beginning of the conference.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FORMAT OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Requirements for the formatting of articles.

- 1.1. text A4 format; line spacing single; font "Times New Roman", font size 12 p.t; page parameters: top and bottom 2 cm, left and right 2 cm. Paragraph indent 1 cm. Width alignment.
 - the use of automatic numbering in the text is not allowed;
 - the use of hyphens is not allowed;
 - the use of italics and bold font is not allowed (except for the title).
- 1.2. If there are tables, diagrams, figures, the text must contain references to their numbering, and the diagrams and figures themselves must be presented in separate files;
 - 1.3. UDC number in accordance with the Universal Decimal Classification;
 - 1.4. The title of the article is in CAPITAL letters in the middle of the line. The font is bold.
- FULL NAME. author and supervisor (if any) in the center of the page in lowercase letters in full (no more than 3 authors);
- after 1 line gap, in the middle, in a regular font in lowercase letters, the full name of the organization (legal entity) that is the author's place of work, city, country is written;
 - after 1 line skip, the abstract of the article is printed no more than 200 characters;
 - keywords -5-7 words;
 - after 1 line skip, the text of the article is from the red line, aligned in width.
- 1.5. at the end of the article, after 1 line, a list of literature used by the author. Sources in the "Literature" section are arranged in alphabetical order. Links to relevant works contain the source number in accordance with the list of references used.
- 1.6. the article must be presented electronically on disk or sent by email (file in doc. or rtf. format), drawings, diagrams as separate files in jpg format;
 - 1.7. article volume no more than 4 pages, including illustrations, diagrams, etc.;
- 1.8. the name of the text file is the author's surname in Latin letters, followed by an underscore and the abbreviation of the educational institution (example: Amanov_tsaci.doc);
- 1.9. Drawings: any graphic materials (drawing, diagram, diagram, drawing, photograph) are designated "Fig." and are numbered with Arabic numerals. Designation located under the picture on the next line in the center.

Example:

Fig. 1. Title of the drawing

The drawing is separated from the text at the top and bottom by a blank line. All figures in the text must have links (Fig. 1).

1.10. Tables: are designated by the word "Table" and are numbered with Arabic numerals. The designation and serial number of the table (without a dot) are aligned to the right; the table name is on the next line, centered. It's highlighted in bold.
